7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 460, 8 L.D. 562, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for an Analysis 9 of the Future of Maine's Forest Resources."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of sections 2 and 3 and inserting in their place the following:

- 'Sec. 2. Steering committee established. There is a steering committee established, the members of which are to be selected by a panel consisting of the Commissioner of Conservation who shall act as chairman of the selection panel and shall call the initial meeting of the steering committee, the Dean of the College of Forest Resources of the University of Maine and the Vice-President of the American Forest Institute. The steering committee shall be composed of 12 to 15 members who shall be representatives of all segments of the forestry community and forestry interests. Steering committee members shall further be those individuals with knowledge, experience and interest in the forest resources of the State. The chairman of the committee shall be selected by the committee members.
- Sec. 3. Conference and report. The steering committee, with assistance from the Department of Conservation, will work to:
- 1. Develop the 2nd Blaine House Conference on Forestry which will focus on the results, interpretation and impact of the United States Forest Service study upon the future of Maine's forest resources; and
 - Issue a report containing the proceedings of the conference, together with any recommendations and appropriate legislation, to the Second Regular
