30	and to charge fees for those services. The fees
31	shall be deposited with the Treasurer of State to be
32	credited to a special account and the commissioner is
33	authorized to expend funds from this account to cover

## STATEMENT OF FACT

5

 The Department of Educational and Cultural Services receives requests to provide public services which are compatible with the authority and responsibilities of the department, but are not included in its appropriations. The beneficiaries of such services are often willing to pay the cost of the services, but the regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration do not permit the expenditure of fees to cover costs without the express consent of the Legislature. The passage of this resolve would record the consent of the Legislature to expend fees to cover the costs of services.
