AN ACT to Permit the Use of the Drug Dimethyl Sulfoxide for Human Consumption.	
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:	
22 MRSA §2216 is enacted to read:	
§2216. Dimethyl sulfoxide	
1. Authorization. It is lawful for physicians,	
drug jobbers, drug wholesalers, drug manufacturers,	
pharmacists and pharmacies registered under Title 32,	
section 2901, to deal professionally with dimethyl	
sulfoxide.	
2. Deal professionally. As used in this	
section, "to deal professionally" means:	

1 2 3	A. In the case of a physician, in good faith and to his own patients as part of professional treatment, to prescribe, administer or deliver,

5 6 7 8 9	B. In the case of a drug jobber, drug wholesaler or drug manufacturer, in good faith, to possess, sell, furnish, give away or offer to sell, fur- nish or give away to pharmacists, pharmacies, physicians, hospitals and to each other; or
