7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:

9 Sec. 1. Allocation of Public Utilities Commis-10 sion Regulatory Fund. Income to the Public Utilities 11 Commission Regulatory Fund for the next 2 fiscal 12 years, from July 1, 1983, to June 30, 1984, and from 13 July 1, 1984, to June 30, 1985, shall be segregated, 14 apportioned and disbursed as designated in the fol-15 lowing schedule:
