The commissioner may charge a fee for the training of private industrial fire brigades. The amount of the fee shall reflect, but not be limited to, instructional, material and administrative costs.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

Presently, only a minimum amount of training is being provided to private industrial fire brigades despite a heavy demand for this training. The fire service training program does not have the fiscal resources to meet this large demand without sacrificing its delivery of services to municipal and volunteer fire fighters. This bill allows services to be offered to these private industrial fire brigades at their expense.
