## STATEMENT OF FACT

There are no municipalities in which the State Liquor Commission operates State Liquor Stores that have ever had the opportunity to vote upon the question in Title 28, section 101, subsection 5. Accordingly, all state liquor stores must remain closed on Sunday, including the Kittery store. Enactment of this bill would, at the written request of the State Liquor Commission, allow that question to be voted upon by the voters of that particular municipality. That vote could be accomplished only once. All subsequent votes would be by the petition process only.
