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AN ACT Pertaining to Inspection of  
Fire Trucks.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

29 MRSA §2506-A is enacted to read:

§2506-A. Inspection of fire trucks

Fire trucks subject to this chapter shall either  
be driven to an official inspection station or the  
fire chief or the elected municipal officials of a  
municipality without a fire chief may contract with  
any licensed inspection station for the services of a  
licensed inspection mechanic to perform an inspection

1 at the location where the fire trucks are customarily  
2 kept.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This new draft requires fire trucks to be  
5 inspected, but fire trucks may be inspected on the  
6 premises where the fire trucks are customarily  
7 housed. The fire chief may contract with a licensed  
8 inspection station for the services of a licensed  
9 inspection mechanic to conduct the inspection at the  
10 fire station. This new draft also allows fire trucks  
11 to be driven to an official inspection station for an  
12 inspection.

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
