19 20	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
. 21	29 MRSA §903-A is enacted to read:
22	§903-A. Motor trucks with weight under 23,000 pounds
23 24 25 26 27 28	Notwithstanding sections 902 and 903, any motor truck may travel on any way or bridge over which motor trucks which are registered for a maximum gross vehicle weight of over 23,000 pounds are prohibited, if the actual gross vehicle weight of the vehicle at the time is less than 23,000 pounds.

1	Statement of Fact
2 3 4 5 6 7	The purpose of this bill is to allow a truck to travel on posted roads if its actual weight with a load is under 23,000 pounds. Currently, trucks registered for over 23,000 pounds, even though traveling empty, are prohibited from traveling on posted roads.
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
