26 27 28 29 30	Any person who steals any agricultural or for- estry product from a commercial farm in Maine which offers farm products for sale commits a civil viola- tion for which a forfeiture of not less than \$200 nor more than \$1,000 may be adjudged.

2 3 4	This bill establishes a minimum fine of \$200 for anyone convicted of stealing agricultural or forestry products from a commercial farm.
