17 AN ACT to Permit Persons Under 18 years
18 of age who pass the Test for General Educa-
19 tional Development to Receive a High School
20 Equivalency Certificate at that Time.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 20-A MRSA §257, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1981, c.
25 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed and the following enacted
26 in its place:

27 1. Issue. The commissioner shall issue high
28 school equivalency certificates to residents of the
29 State who:

30 A. Demonstrate through procedures prescribed by
31 the commissioner that they have attained a gen-
32 eral educational development comparable to that
33 of secondary school graduates;
