STATEMENT OF FACT

At present, when a municipality disconnects a street lighting fixture, the electrical power company requires a lump sum payment for the remaining value of the fixture. This places an undue burden on the municipality and creates a barrier to conservation. The bill requires that payment be amortized over the remaining useful life of the fixture.

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
