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AN ACT to Repeal the Law Providing an  
Open Season on Moose.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 118, §2, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7464, as amended by PL 1981, c. 118, §§3 to 9, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the present law permitting the hunting of moose.

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
