16 17 18	IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE
19 20 21 22	AN ACT to Permit the Use of Illuminated Signs on Motor Trucks, Semitrailers and Truck Tractors.
23 24	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
25 26 27	29 MRSA §1374 , as amended by PL 1979, c. 127, §167, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
28	§1374. Advertisements on motor vehicles
29	No person, firm or corporation may operate or
30	cause to be operated on public highways and streets
31	any motor vehicle to which is affixed any advertise-
32	ment that is illuminated, except as provided in this
33	section.

1 For purposes of vehicle identification, in addition to the provisions of section 1403, any motor truck, truck tractor or semitrailer may display an 2 3 4 illuminated sign in accordance with rules adopted by 5 the Commissioner of Public Safety according to the 6 Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 7 375. Among any other standards that the Commissioner of Public Safety deems necessary to protect the wel-8 9 fare and safety of the general public, the following 10 standards shall be included in the rules. 1. Information on sign. Any illuminated sign dis-11 12 played on a truck tractor, semitrailer or motor truck 13 shall bear the name or name and address of the owner 14 of the vehicle, the lessee of the vehicle or the firm or corporation for which the operator is transporting 15 property or goods. The Commissioner of Public Safety 16 may authorize an illuminated sign to identify 17 the 18 cargo in transit. 19 2. Location of sign. Illuminated signs shall be 20 displayed as follows. A. On truck tractors, the illuminated sign shall 21 22 be placed on the wind deflector on the roof of 23 the truck tractor. 24 B. On a semitrailer, the illuminated sign shall 25 be placed on the front portion of the semitrail-26 er. C. On a motor truck, the illuminated sign shall be placed on the front portion of the storage 27 28 29 compartment above and behind that part of the 30 vehicle referred to as the "cab." Types of lights prohibited. Any illuminated 31 3. sign authorized by this section shall not be lighted 32 33 by a flashing, blinking or neon light. 4. Form, size and light of sign. Any illuminated 34 sign shall be in a form, size and light so as not to 35 36 distract or impair the vision of the operator of any other vehicle approaching, next to or departing from 37 38 the motor vehicle with the illuminated sign.

1	This section shall not apply to the illuminated
2	name and telephone number identification affixed to
3	vehicles for the conveyance of passengers.
4	STATEMENT OF FACT
5	This new draft changes the bill, L.D. 73, sub-
6	stantially as described below. According to the new
7	draft:
8	1. Illuminated signs may be displayed only on
9	motor trucks, semitrailers and truck tractors;
10	2. Illuminated signs may bear only the name or
11	the name and address of the owner, lessee or firm or
12	corporation for which the operator is transporting
13	property or goods;
14	3. Illuminated signs are limited to the front
15	portions of trucks;
16	4. Flashing, blinking or neon lighted signs are
17	prohibited; and
18	5. The Commissioner of Public Safety is required
19	to issue rules with respect to standards for install-
20	ing illuminated signs. The standards require that
21	illuminated signs shall not distract or impair the
22	vision of operators of other vehicles on the highway.
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
