22 23 24	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
25 26 27 28 29	Whereas, prompt determination and certification of the municipal cost components in the unorganized territory tax district is necessary to the establishment of a mill rate and the levy of the unorganized territory educational and services tax; and
30 31 32 33 34 35	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

1 2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine a follows:

In accordance with the Revised Statutes Title 36, chapter 115, the Legislature determine that the net municipal cost component for service and reimbursements to be rendered in fiscal year 1983-84 is \$8,015,081, as reflected in the following list.
