19 20	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
21 22	<pre>Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §2151, as amended by PL 1979, c. 731, §19, is further amended to read:</pre>
23	§2151. Creation and membership
24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34	A Seed Potato Board, as heretefere established in the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, shall consist of the commissioner, who shall serve as an ex officio member, and 6 additional members appointed by him. Of the 6 appointed mem- bers, 5 shall be chosen from representatives of the potato industry in Aroostook County and one from elsewhere in the State of Maine. Of the appointed members, at least one shall be a potato processor grower and at least one shall be a potato tablestock grower.

Sec. 2. 7 MRSA §2152, first ¶, as repealed and
replaced by PL 1971, c. 594, §9, is amended to read:

3 Each appointed member shall serve for a term of 3 4 years or until his successor has been appointed and 5 qualified. <u>No appointed member may serve more than 2</u> 6 complete consecutive terms.

7 Sec. 3. Transition. Members of the Seed Potato 8 Board as of the effective date of this Act shall con-9 tinue to serve their present terms. As any vacancies arise after the effective date of this Act, 10 appointments shall be made so that a potato processor grower 11 12 and a potato tablestock grower are appointed to the 13 board as soon as possible after the effective date of 14 this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 The purpose of this bill is to provide for а 17 potato processor grower and potato tablestock grower 18 to be included as members of the Seed Potato Board. 19 It limits terms of members to 2 consecutive terms 20 and provides that the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will become an ex officio 21 22 member of the board.

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
