AN ACT to Provide for the Negotiation of Union Security Provisions.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
26 MRSA §964, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:
2-A. Negotiation of union security. Nothing in
this chapter may be interpreted to prohibit the negotiation of union security, except in closed shop.
STATEMENT OF FACT
The purpose of this bill is to permit the nego-
tiation of union security provisions into collective
bargaining agreements for municipal public employees.
