## 1 STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to clarify that health care providers have the right to require, as a condition of professionals practicing at their facilities, that they carry medical malpractice insurance.

Also, the bill clarifies that by requiring insurance coverage, the health care provider, by that requirement alone, does not increase its own liability to patients or others.

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
