26 27 28 29	7. Fee. The fee for the license shall be \$33 for applicants 17 years of age or older and under 70 years of age, and \$13 for those applicants under 17 years of age or 70 years of age or older.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft provides commercial lobster and crab licenses to persons 70 years of age or older for \$13, the same as the fee for persons under 17. There are no special restrictions on this license. This new draft will result in a loss of approximately \$6,000 annually to the General Fund.
