7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 671, L.D. 854, 8 Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Financial Responsibility 9 of the County for Medical Expenses of Prisoners."

10 Amend the bill in the 3rd and 4th lines after the 11 amending clause (page 1, lines 27 and 28 in L.D.) by 12 striking out the underlined words "<u>being held or sen-</u> 13 <u>tenced to a county jail</u>" and inserting in their place 14 the underlined words '<u>during the month in which he</u> 15 <u>becomes an inmate only to the extent permitted by</u> 16 federal law'

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This amendment puts into statute current Medicaid eligibility practices which, consistent with federal 19 20 law, permit inmates of public institutions to be 21 Medicaid eligible during the first partial month in 22 which they become inmates. This eligibility under 23 state law would remain conditioned on its conformance 24 with federal law, thus assuring the availability of 25 federal matching funds.
