4 Sec. 2. Revision authorized. Wherever in the Revised Statutes, Title 32, sections 301 to 5 408 and 6 sections 1551 to 1657-A, words or terms referring to 7 the regulation of schools appear, those words or are repealed and the Director of Legislative 8 terms 9 Research may remove those or similar combinations of words and modify the text where necessary to retain 10 the intent of each statute without the repealed text. 11

STATEMENT OF FACT

13 This bill removes the regulation of schools of 14 barbering and schools of hairdressing and beauty cul-15 ture from the respective licensing boards of barbers 16 and cosmetologists. Section 1 of the bill removes 17 the exception of hairdressing and beauty culture 18 schools from regulation under the education laws.

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
