1-A. Information on assistance programs. At the time a claim for benefits is filed, the claimant shall be furnished with written information on all public assistance and income supplementation programs currently in operation in this State. The Bureau of Employment Security shall obtain copies for distribution from the Department of Human Services, as required under Title 22, section 3106.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Many people who file a claim for unemployment benefits are unfamiliar with the many available programs of public assistance and income supplementation that could assist them in a difficult financial situation. The purpose of this bill is to provide claimants with information about these other programs.

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
