## 1 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to provide the Commissioner of Labor with the necessary authority to administer the Bureau of Employment Security and the unemployment insurance law. This amendment requires the Unemployment Insurance Commission to obtain the consent of the Commissioner of Labor prior to the commission promulgating rules. In this way, the administrative authority of the commissioner is not obstructed.
