and there are no assets of the employer from which earned wages may be paid, or when the employer has filed under any provision of the Federal Bankruptcy Act. No officer or director in the case of a corporation, no partner in the case of a partnership and no owner in the case of a sole proprietorship shall may be considered an employee for purposes of this section.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The Maine Wage Assurance Fund provides for the payment of one week's wage to employees who are owed wages from an employer without assets and no longer operating a business. In fiscal year 1981, 195 employees received wages from this fund, but 47 of these employees had earned 2 or more weeks' wages and received no payment for services during any of the additional weeks worked.
