17 AN ACT to Clarify the Use of Vocational-  
18 technical Institutes' Facilities by Others.  
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 20-A MRSA §10104, sub-§2, ¶¶D and F, as enacted  
23 by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, are amended to read:

24 D. Charge tuition and other reasonable fees,  
25 including fees for the reasonable use of the  
26 institutes' facilities by others;

27 F. Accept and expend all funds for  
28 post-secondary vocational education received by  
29 the department from:

30 (1) The General Fund;

1 (2) Gifts and donations either from public  
2 or private sources which are offered uncon-  
3 ditionally; or

4 (3) Fees charged pursuant to paragraph D.  
5

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 This bill clarifies that the State Board of Edu-  
8 cation has the authority to make the  
9 vocational-technical institute facilities available  
10 to other parties for a fee, and that those fees are  
11 included within the term "fees" set forth in Title  
12 20, section 2263, subsection 2, paragraphs D and F  
13 and Title 20-A, section 10104, subsection 2, para-  
14 graphs D and F.
