## STATEMENT OF FACT

This is designed to allow for the sale in the State of scallops that have been harvested beyond the territorial waters of the State. Present law will not allow a vessel rigged to fish to sell or transport species. This is a specific exemption to allow large offshore scallop fishermen to come into Maine ports and sell their scallops.

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
