17 AN ACT to Amend the Wholesale Seafood
18 License Law.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §6851, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1979, c.
23 590, §2, is further amended to read:

24 4. License limited. A license shall only author-
25 ize these activities at one establishment or with one
26 vehicle, but not on a vessel rigged to fish, pro-
27 vided, that this license shall also authorize the
28 sale and transportation of scallops from any vessel.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This is designed to allow for the sale in the
3 State of scallops that have been harvested beyond the
4 territorial waters of the State. Present law will
5 not allow a vessel rigged to fish to sell or trans-
6 port species. This is a specific exemption to allow
7 large offshore scallop fishermen to come into Maine
8 ports and sell their scallops.
