Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

13 'Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the follow-ing abbreviation and figure: 'Sec. 1.' 14 15

16 Further amend the amendment by inserting before 17 the Statement of Fact the following:

18 'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall not be effective unless, within 60 days of the adjournment of the Legislature, the Secretary of State receives 19 20 written certification by the Joint Tribal Council of 21 22 the Passamaquoddy Tribe and the governor and council 23 of the Penobscot Nation that the respective tribe and 24 nation have agreed to the provisions of this Act pursuant to the United States Code, Title 25, Section 1725(e) (1), copies of which shall be submitted by 25 26 27 the Secretary of State to the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House; provided that in no event 28 29 may this Act become effective until 90 days after ad-30 journment of the Legislature.'
