20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22	5 MRSA §7002, sub-§2, ¶K is enacted to read:
23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30	K. The director shall implement a program designed to assist new and expanding economic ac- tivities in satisfying the regulatory require- ments of the State. This program includes provi- sions to identify regulatory requirements for businesses that request the assistance, and to coordinate issuance of licenses and permits by state agencies.

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2	Economic activity is crucial to the future wel-
3	fare of the State. Current regulatory requirements
4	hinder, rather than encourage, new and expanding
5	business and industry. This bill directs the Direc-
6	tor of the State Development Office to establish a
7	program to assist businesses in identifying and meet-
8	ing regulatory requirements, and to coordinate li-
9	cense and permit review among the applicable state
10	agencies.
