STATEMENT OF FACT

 Beverage containers sold to airlines containing beverage intended for consumption on an aircraft flight originating or terminating in a foreign country are exempt from the bottle bill.

The purpose of this bill is to provide the same exemption for beverage containers sold to domestic airlines containing beverage intended for consumption on an interstate aircraft flight. Some of these airlines are now purchasing beverage outside of the State to avoid compliance with the state law.
