13 14 15	'28 MRSA §667, as amended by PL 1981, c. 572, is further amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph a new paragraph to read:
16 17 18 19 20	The sale and delivery of wine to retail licensees accomplished completely at the wholesale licensee's principal warehouse shall be considered a sale and delivery within the assigned territory of that wholesaler.'
21	STATEMENT OF FACT
22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31	The purpose of this amendment is to allow a retail licensee to purchase wine from a wholesaler other than the wholesaler assigned the exclusive sales territory in his area if the retail licensee travels to the wholesaler's principal warehouse. The retailer is required to complete the sale and take delivery of the wine at the warehouse and transport the products himself. The statute still prohibits wholesalers from soliciting, selling or delivering products outside their exclusive territory.
