The inclusion of sexual abuse and exploitation under the category of neglect is inappropriate as it does not accurately reflect the severity of such acts. This proposed change is consistent with accepted definitions of abuse. Additionally, this clarification will allow more accurate compilation of data concerning the incidence of adult abuse in this State.
