This amendment deletes language limiting the  
jurisdictions from which lawful wiretap orders could  
be admissible in Maine courts. The bill, as amended,  
will allow wire and oral communications to be admit-  
ted into evidence in Maine courts from any jurisdic-  
tion, including Canada.
