21	of-way.
22	STATEMENT OF FACT
23	The purpose of this amendment is to clearly dis-
24	tinguish the type of vehicle and operator who has the
25 26	right-of-way. According to this amendment, a police
27	officer who witnesses a violation of the law or who has probable cause to believe that a person has vio-
28	lated the law, has the right-of-way in traffic. The
29	police officer does not have to wait for a call in
30	order to obtain the right-of-way in an emergency
31	situation.
