20 21 22 23 24 25 26	This amendment would authorize rangers of the Bureau of Forestry and game wardens, as well as police officers and sheriffs, to make inspections, investigations and arrests under this Title 12, chapter 805, subchapter III, Article 2. It would not require the Bureau of Forestry to hire additional permanent or temporary staff.
