11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18	Amend the bill in the underlined paragraph after the amending clause by inserting after the first sentence (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) the following: 'The utility or utilities may, at the time of the filing of notice of its intent to file the petition, request the commission to waive all or a portion of the filing fee. The commission shall rule on the request for waiver within 60 days.'
20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27	Further amend the bill at the end of the under- lined paragraph after the amending clause (page 1, line 34 in L.D.) by adding the following: 'Any por- tion of the filing fee that is received from any utility or utilities and is not expended by the com- mission to process the petition for a certification of public convenience and necessity shall be returned to the utility or utilities.'
28 29 30	Further amend the bill at the end before the Statement of Fact by adding the following new paragraph:
31 32 33 34 35 36 37	'Notwithstanding any other requirement in this section, the commission may, by rule, exempt from filing fees applications concerning transmission lines not associated with a major new generating facility or construction of small generating facilities, the review of which does not place an unusual burden on the commission's budget.'
