STATEMENT OF FACT

4 Due to cutbacks in federal funding, the Depart-5 ment of Attorney General has resorted to handling over 3,000 consumer complaints a year with volunteer 6 mediators. Many of these dedicated individuals drive 7 8 miles and suffer significant out-of-cost long 9 expenses in this effort. While the work should 10 remain volunteer, these individuals should at least have the opportunity to have some of their actual 11 expenses defrayed. 12
