AN ACT Concerning a Judge Hearing a Case where his Town or County is a Party.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
14 MRSA §1102 is repealed.
STATEMENT OF FACT
Under current law, the adverse party in a claim against a town or county can unilaterally decide whether a judge who is a resident of that town or county will hear the claim. This bill repeals that provision of law.
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
