of benefits and similar issues. The compilation shall be indexed conveniently to facilitate its use by the public, available in each local office where unemployment claims are filed and easily accessible to any member of the public.

Sec. 2. Transition provision. The compilation shall be completed by the Commissioner of Labor no later than July 1, 1984.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the statutory placement of the provision from Title 26, section 1194, the claims for benefits section, to Title 26, section 1082, subsection 3, which deals with other publications that the Commissioner of Labor is required to make available to the public. The provision has been reworded to make clear the intent of the Legislature that all internal policies, rules, regulations, memoranda and instructions must be compiled in order to be easily available for public use.
