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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes unorganized townships to adopt shellfish conservation programs similar to programs in organized municipalities. The county commissioners will act as the municipal legislative body, provided that the majority of the inhabitants have voted to adopt a conservation program. Any necessary funding could be raised through the unorganized territories educational and services tax.

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
