23	21 MRSA §1395-A is enacted to read:
24	§1395-A. Campaign limitations
25 26 27 28 29	1. Prohibition. No expenditures, as defined in this chapter, may be made by or on behalf of any candidate in any general election prior to 60 days before that general election, except as provided in subsection 2.
30 31 32	2. Exceptions. Nothing in this section may limit the amount an individual may spend on his campaign, provided that money spent prior to the date

1	set out in subsection 1 is derived from the personal
2	funds of the candidate or his spouse.
3	STATEMENT OF FACT
4	The purpose of this bill is to restrict campaign
5	time for general election candidates to 60 days prior
6	to the general election.
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
