7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 927,
8 L.D. 1206, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Inspection of
9 Hotel Records by Police Officers."

10 Amend the bill in that part designated "\$2801."
11 in the 5th, 6th and 7th lines from the end (page 2
12 lines 11 to 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following
13 "the sheriff and his deputies or any state duly
14 authorized police officer" and inserting in their
15 place the following 'the sheriff and his deputies or
16 any state police officer any full-time law enforce-
17 ment officer as defined in Title 25, section 2805'

18 STATEMENT OF FACT

19 The amendment permits any full-time law enforce-
20 ment officer, as defined in Title 25, section 2805,
21 to inspect hotel and lodging house records. This
22 would include sheriffs and their deputies, state
23 police officers and local police officers who work on
24 a full-time basis and thus avoids concerns that part-
25 time deputies, local police officers or other offi-
26 cials would have access to such information.
