19	The amendment permits any full-time law enforce-
20 21	ment officer, as defined in Title 25, section 2805, to inspect hotel and lodging house records. This
22	would include sheriffs and their deputies, state
24	police officers and local police officers who work on a full-time basis and thus avoids concerns that part-
25 26	time deputies, local police officers or other officials would have access to such information.
