1 L.D. 1207 2 (Filing No. H- 522) 3 STATE OF MAINE 4 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 5 111TH LEGISLATURE 6 SECOND REGULAR SESSION HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 928, L.D. 7 Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Menhaden Fishing in Casco 8 Bay." 9 10 Amend the bill in that part designated "§6572." by striking out all of the first underlined paragraph 11 (page 1, lines 24 to 28 in L.D.) and inserting in its 12 13 place the following: 14 'It is unlawful to fish for or take menhaden by 15 purse or stop seine without a permit from the Depart-16 ment of Marine Resources in the area of Casco Bay in 17 Cumberland County beginning at the southern tip of West Cundy Point westerly to the navigational buoy N 18 "4"; then continuing southwesterly to the northern tip of Ram Island; then continuing southwesterly to 19 20 21 and along the eastern shore of Jaquish Island to its southern tip; then westerly to the navigational buoy R "2"; continuing westerly to the navigational buoy N "4"; then continuing northwesterly to the 22 23 24 navigational buoy C "3"; then continuing northerly to 25 26 the navigational buoy RBN; then continuing northerly 27 to the navigational gong BR south of Whaleboat Is-28 land; then continuing northerly to the eastern tip of 29 Upper Green Island; then continuing easterly to and along the northern shore of Little Whaleboat Island; then continuing easterly to the northwestern tip of Curtis Cove on Harpswell Neck. This shall include 30 31 32 all the waters of Quahog Bay, Merriconeag Sound and 33 Harpswell Sound. In addition, it is unlawful to fish 34 for or take menhaden by purse or stop seine in the 35 36 area of the New Meadows River, north of a line from 37 the southern most tip of Foster Point, westerly to

the northern most tip of Indian Point.
