22 23 24	<b>Emergency preamble.</b> Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
25 26 27	Whereas, the 90-day period will not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and
28 29 30 31	Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci- dent to the operation of the Low-level Waste Siting Commission will become due and payable on or immedi- ately after July 1, 1983; and
32 33	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-2 3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 4 therefore,

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 6

7 Allocation of the Low-level Waste Siting Fund. Income to the Low-level Waste Siting Fund for the 8 next 2 fiscal years, from July 1, 1983, to June 30, 9 1984, and from July 1, 1984, to June 30, 1985, shall 10 be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as desig-11 nated in the following schedule. 12
