AN ACT to Establish a Recreational Lobster Fishing License.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
12 MRSA §6421, sub-§7-A is enacted to read:
7-A. Recreational license. A recreational li-
cense may be issued to any person. The fee for the
recreational license is \$33. No person fishing with
a recreational license may set or haul more than 25
traps. The license shall indicate on its face that
the licensee is limited to the use of no more than 25
traps at any one time. No catch taken with a recrea-
tional license may be offered for sale or barter.
