18 19 20 21	AN ACT to Amend the Statute Relative to the Appointment of the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services.
22 23	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
24 25 26	<b>20-A MRSA §251, sub-§1,</b> as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
27 28 29 30 31	1. Appointment. The commissioner shall be appointed by the Governor, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and to confirmation by the Legislature.
32 33	A. The Governor shall include the chairman of the State Board of Education in the selection

- process and shall ensure that the state board has
   an opportunity to meet and interview the candi date or candidates.
- B. Within 10 days of meeting with the candidate
  or candidates, the state board shall deliver to
  the Governor its written appraisal of the
  strengths and weaknesses of the candidate or candidates and a list of board members approving and
  disapproving the appointment of the candidate or
  candidates.
- 11C. The Governor shall consider the approval of12the state board prior to posting the nomination13of a candidate.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

15 This new draft changes the existing law concern-16 ing the appointment of the Commissioner of Educa-17 tional and Cultural Services to provide for appoint-18 ment by the Governor with consultation and review by 19 the State Board of Education.

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
