AN ACT Authorizing the Public Utilities Commission to Expend Revenues Collected as Filing Fees or Expense Reimbursements.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

much thereof as may be required is appropriated for these purposes. All such payments shall be made to the commission after approval of the State Controller and in no event may the payments exceed the amounts received by the Treasurer of State from the Public Utilities Commission.

 Fines collected by the Public Utilities Commission which do not constitute a reimbursement of commission expenses shall be deposited in the General Fund of the State Treasury. Upon certification by the secretary of the commission that certain amounts in the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fund are not required by the commission, the Treasurer of State shall transfer the amounts to the General Fund.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides a means by which the Public Utilities Commission may be reimbursed from money collected by it to cover its costs of processing specific cases.
