Permit for a resident to be issued or denied 1 11. within 30 days; permit for a nonresident to be issued 2 3 or denied within 90 days. The issuing authority, as 4 set forth in this section, shall issue or deny, and 5 reply in writing as to the reason for any refusal, within 30 days of the application date in the case of 6 7 a resident and within 90 days of the application date 8 in the case of a nonresident.

STATEMENT OF FACT

10 A dramatic increase in the number of nonresident 11 applications have been received since the most cur-12 rent law change. This has placed an added burden on 13 the issuing authority to conduct investigations and 14 issue licenses in large numbers. To help accomplish 15 this effort, additional personnel will be possible 16 with the new revenue.
