HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 439, L.D. 1318,
Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to the Political Rights of
State Employees."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§14." in
subsection 2 in paragraph A by adding at the end the
following sentence: 'No officer or employee of the
State may be a candidate for elective office in
public elections for state offices.'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated
"§14." by striking out all of subsection 3 and
inserting in its place the following:

'3. Exclusions. This section shall not apply to
constitutional officers of the State or to elected
officials.

4. Penalty. Any violations of this section con-
stitute a Class E crime.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is two-fold. In the
3 first case, the constitutional officers and elected
4 officials are excluded from the proposed law. In the
5 2nd case, there is a clear prohibition against state
6 employees running for state offices.
