10 11 12 13 14	Amend the Bill in that part designated "§14." in subsection 2 in paragraph A by adding at the end the following sentence: 'No officer or employee of the State may be a candidate for elective office in public elections for state offices.'
15 16 17	Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§14." by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place the following:
18 19 20	'3. Exclusions. This section shall not apply to constitutional officers of the State or to elected officials.
21 . 22	4. Penalty. Any violations of this section constitute a Class E crime.

2 3 4 5 6	The purpose of this amendment is two-fold. In the first case, the constitutional officers and elected officials are excluded from the proposed law. In the 2nd case, there is a clear prohibition against state employees running for state offices.
